Bologna May 27th 1860 - Theodore
Parker, seemed to be in my chamber
about midnight last night - a spirit
heard raps, then an impression as of
him - He said a great deal by inspiration,
said my difficulty as a medium was my
commitment to be led by others -
I remarked that I thought I was very
easily ~~led~~ induced to follow others -
He said he thought your affection &
but your intellectual constitution is
independent and will ~~not~~ yield only to its
own convictions, a reasoning -

He said also Parker & Party are in Paris
but ^{not at same house with Appletons} only 2 days - will go to England
before sailing for America, will cross the
Atlantic with the Appletons.

He said much about Spiritual Manifestation
and of the difficulties the subject presented
to his mind in life - He now saw why he could
not appreciate the evidence he had witnessed of
their reality.
